## YOU WILL NEED

- 50g balls of Paintbox Yarns Metallic DK (As seen on cover) · 9 [10: 11: 11: 12: 13: 14] × Tequila Sunrise
- Pair of 3.75mm (UK 9 - US 5) knitting needles
- Pair of 4mm (UK 8 - US 6) knitting needles

## TENSION (GAUGE)

24 sts and 36 rows over st st and 19 sts and 20 rows over dropped st patt, both to 10 cm, 4 in, square using 4mm (UK 8 - US 6) needles, or size required to give correct tension (*gauge*).

It is vitally important to check your tension (*gauge*) before starting as working to the wrong tension (*gauge*) will mean your item will not be the size shown and could result in yarn being left over, or more yarn being required. Before beginning, knit a tension (*gauge*) swatch at least 13 cm, 5 in, square and measure your tension (*gauge*). If there are more sts and rows than stated, try again using thicker needles. If there are less sts and rows than stated, try again using thinner needles.

## GOOD TO KNOW

- Paintbox Yarns cannot accept responsibility for the finished item if any yarn other than the recommended yarn is used.
- Yarn quantities are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.
- Colour reproduction is as close as printing processes will allow.
- Instructions are written using UK terminology with changes for US terminology given in *italics* in round brackets ( ) afterwards.
- Repeat figures in round brackets ( ) the number of times stated afterwards.
- Instructions are given for the smallest size, with changes for the larger sizes given in square brackets [ ] afterwards.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**cm** = centimetres; **K** = knit; **P** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **st st** = stocking stitch.

## BACK AND FRONT (BOTH ALIKE)

With 3.75mm (UK 9 – US 5) needles, cast on 87 [92: 97: 102: 107: 112: 117] sts.

K 5 rows.

Change to 4mm (UK 8 – US 6) needles.

**1st row** (right side) Winding yarn twice round the needle on every st, K to end.

**2nd row** Dropping extra loop on each st, p to end.

**3rd and 4th rows** K to end.

These 4 rows **form** the patt and are repeated.

Work straight until work measures 57 [58: 59: 60: 61: 62: 63] cm, 22½ [22¾: 23¼: 23¾: 24: 24½: 24¾] in, from cast on edge, ending with a 2nd row.

Change to 3.75mm (UK 9 – US 5) needles.

K 5 rows.

Cast off.

## SLEEVES

With 3.75mm (UK 9 – US 5) needles, cast on 76 [80: 84: 88: 92: 100: 104] sts.

K 5 rows.

Change to 4mm (UK 8 – US 6) needles.

**1st row** (right side) Winding yarn twice round the needle on every st, K to end.

**2nd row** Dropping extra loop on each st, P to end.

**3rd and 4th rows** K to end.

These 4 rows **form** the patt and are repeated.

Work straight until sleeve measures 45 cm, 17¾ in from cast on edge, ending with a 4th row.

Cast off.

## TO MAKE UP

Join shoulder seams for 7 [8: 9: 10: 11: 12: 13] cm,

2¾ [3¼: 3½: 4: 4¼: 4¾: 5] in, at each end. Sew on sleeves.

Join side and sleeve seams.



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
